

## How to Unpack a Zip File

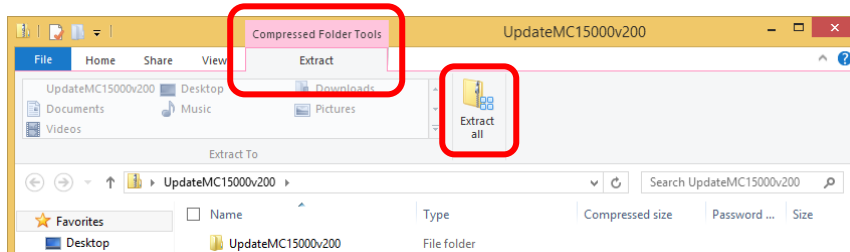
Compressed applications that haven't been unpacked cannot usually be used on Windows. After unpacking the zip file as described below, please carry out the application's boot up procedure.

(For Windows 8 / 8.1 users)

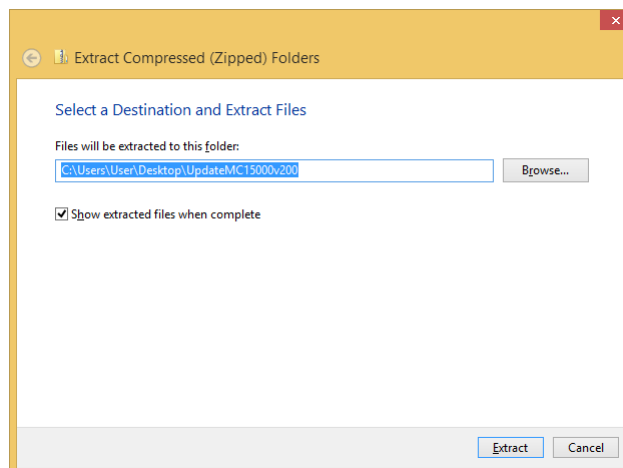
1. Right click on the zip file icon and click **Open** to open the file with Explore.



2. Select **Extract** from the **Compressed Folder Tools** tab, and then click **Extract all**.



3. Select the location where you want the folder to be placed, for example, the Desktop. Select **Show extracted files when complete**. Then click on the **Extract** button. The transferred file will be displayed in a window.

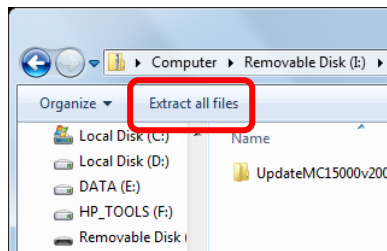


(For Windows Vista / 7 users)

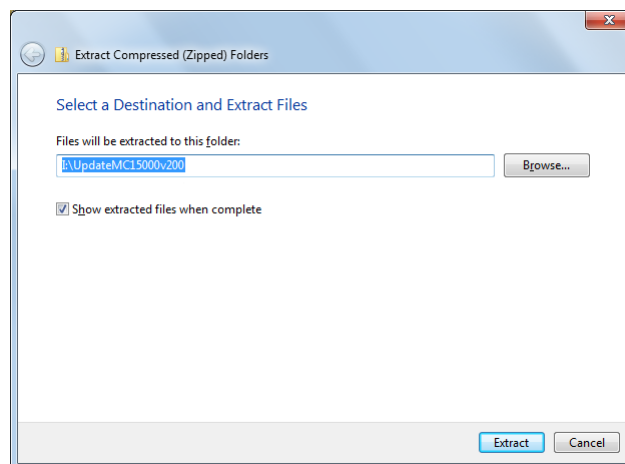
1. Right click on the zip file icon and click **Open** to open the file with Explore.



2. Click on the **Extract all files** button in the window that opens.



3. Select the location where you want the folder to be placed, for example, the Desktop. Select **Show extracted files when complete**. Then click on the **Extract** button. The transferred file will be displayed in a window.

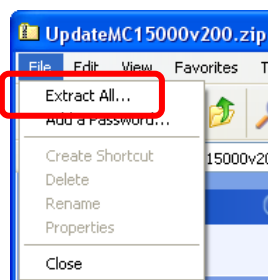


(For Windows XP users)

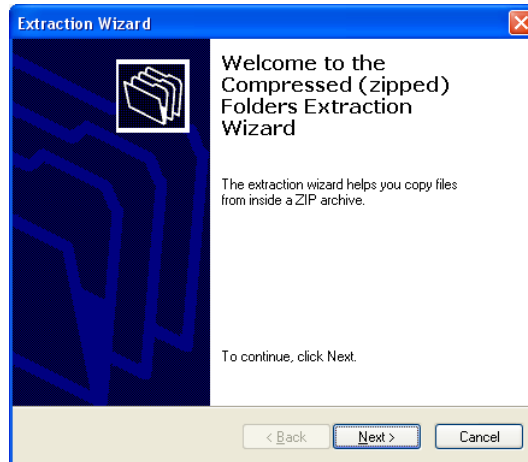
1. Right click on the zip file icon and click **Open** to open the file with Explore.



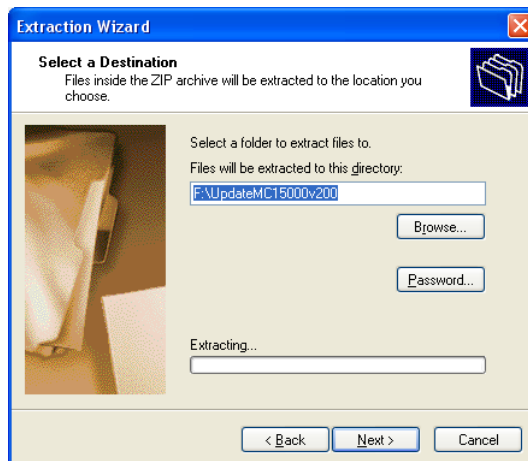
2. In the window that opens, click **Extract all files**.



3. The Extraction Wizard opens. Click **Next**.



4. On the Select a Destination screen, select the location where you want the folder to be placed, for example, the Desktop. Click **Next**.



5. On the Extraction Complete screen, select **Show extracted files**. Click Finish. The unzipped files appear in a new window.
